



## OCEANAIRE WOMEN'S GOLF ASSOCIATION 2023 SEASON GUIDELINES

- All women who are Full or Associate members of the Greenbriar Oceanaire Golf Club with a handicap and have paid the \$10 annual membership fee are MEMBERS of OWGA and can play in the Ladies League on Thursday morning. If you do not currently have a handicap, please contact the Pro Shop who can arrange a "Trending Handicap" to get you started.
- OWGA members will be able to switch back & forth from 9 to 18 hole play provided handicap requirements are met. 18 holes - 0-40; 9 holes - any handicap. The exception to this will be the 1st Thursday of each month during the tournament season, when an 18 hole Shotgun Scramble will be played followed by luncheon. Dates may be subject to change by the OWGA committee. Members are required to sign up separately for golf or luncheon or both. The End of Year luncheon will be held on the last Thursday in September (28th).
- FEES will be \$7 per tournament for 18 holers and \$5 per tournament for 9 holers payable on the day in cash. \$1 per person will be held for End Of Year prizes. The remainder will be distributed as weekly prize money (Pro Shop Credit) with separate pots for 18 and 9 holers. The number of winners and amount distributed will be determined by the number of participants and tournament format.
- Sign Up for OWGA tournaments will be in the Pro Shop and closes at 9 am on the Tuesday of that week.
- CANCELLATION of a tournament. If the course is open, the tournament is on. If you wish to remove your name from a tournament you have signed up for, for any reason (illness, conflicting appointment, weather conditions, Cart Path Only etc), it is your responsibility to inform the Pro Shop by 7:30 am at the latest on the day of the tournament. This allows the Pro Shop time to re-arrange teams, as necessary. Since we require a minimum of 8 golfers per tournament, inclement weather will naturally cancel a tournament where there are insufficient players.
- Only GROSS SCORES are required to be recorded on the Tournament Score Card. A separate Net Score may be recorded on separate card for your individual information.
- USGA Maximum Stroke Count (Double Bogey plus strokes) to set maximum strokes for picking up the ball during play will be used for certain tournaments to be identified in the individual weekly tournament guideline
- Details of FLIGHTS and END OF YEAR PRIZES will be announced before the season begins based on Membership sign up.

## WEEKLY AND END OF YEAR PRIZES 2023

In addition to Pro Shop credit for weekly tournaments, Brag Tag pins will be awarded throughout the year and will be presented at the monthly luncheons. It is the responsibility of the player to record this information on their Score Card in order to receive the pin. THURSDAY PLAY ONLY.

**HOLE IN ONE:** Player to record Hole Number on bottom of score card. Take a picture and send to Rita Nadelman for The Beacon

**TWO/TWO CLUB:** Birdie on Par 3 achieved for the FIRST time this season. Player to record hole number on bottom of score card .

**BREAK 50,60 ( 9 holers) 80,90,100 ( 18 holers):** GROSS SCORE ONLY. Achieved for the first time this season. Circle **○** your gross score.

**END OF YEAR:** Prizes will be awarded at our final luncheon at the end of September. All prizes will be awarded for each individual Flight.

**Most Improved Golfer:** Eligible winners must have played a minimum of 50% of the Ladies League Tournaments

**Most Birdies and Most Chip Ins:** Player to record hole number on bottom of score card

**Ringers:** Best score from each hole produces your best overall score of the season. Calculated for individual events only

### **President' s Award.**

An accumulation of points throughout the season based on the following:

- Participating in 80% of OWGA tournaments = 1 point
- Winning in at least 2 OWGA Individual tournaments = 2 points
- Placing in at least 2 OWGA Individual tournaments = 1 point
- Winning in at least 2 OWGA team tournament = 2 points
- Placing in at least 2 OWGA team tournaments = 1 point
